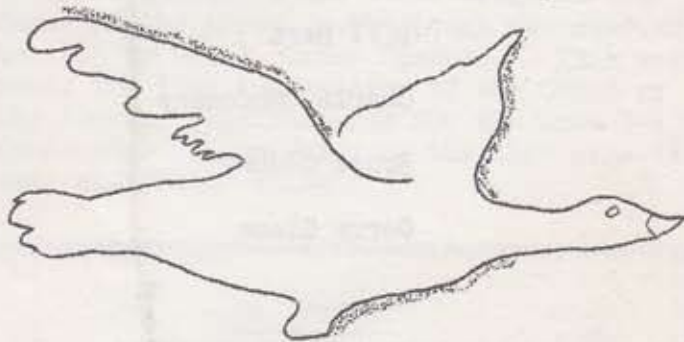

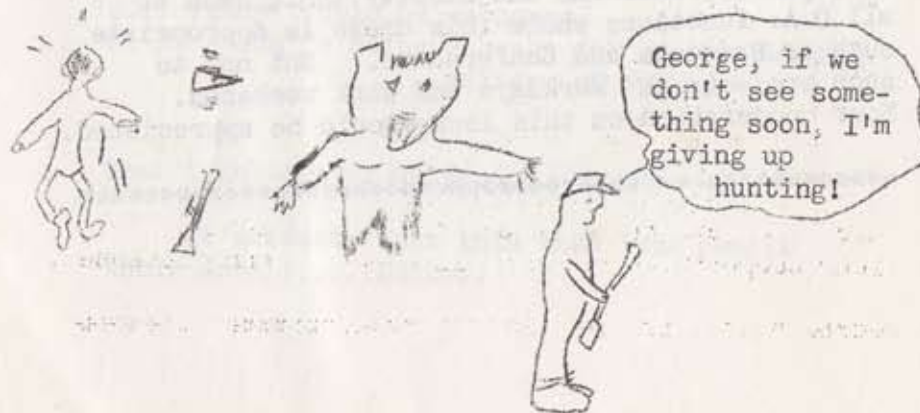
Area 3-A Conference

This is a special conference meeting for it marks the 50th Anniversary of the Order of the Arrow. May I remind you that many members will be applying for a choice number of reservations and it would be advisable to return application blanks as soon as possible. All applications must be in by May 1, 1965. NO applications will be considered after this date. A standard fee of \$6.00 is required of all lodge representatives.
