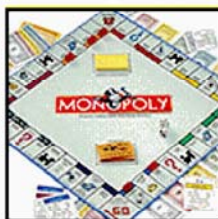

Octoraro had four members attend the Summit; during which they attended numerous training sessions. Many of these sessions taught us the goals of the National Committee and



the lodges role in the implementing these goals. Programs such as Alder's Role of the Section, the Troop/Team Representative Program, and the Quality Lodge Training Session were just a few of the programs talked about at the Summit. The Lodge is in an exciting time in the Order of the Arrow, with many new programs being implemented on a lodge level. A new Committee was formed to start
