Patch Trading!

Are you new to patch trading? Do you need to know everything before you trade on Saturday night? We talked to a few Brothers who traded patches heavily during NOAC, and they had some advice for everybody who wants to start trading!

Scan Your Sets!

On the back of patches, you've probably seen a QR Code, but not thought much of it. The QR codes are very useful, and can help you understand the value of a patch, and learn even more information about it! Try scanning the back of a patch you have, you can see a lot of information about the patch. You can see which lodge created it, how many were made, and even the colors used. Try this on your own!

Be Patient!

There may be a specific patch that you're looking for, maybe from a past convention. Be patient when you're trying to find it, don't take a ridiculous trade for it. You will eventually find somebody with the patch that you want, so make sure that you don't take a bad deal just because you really want that patch, I personally wish I knew this before NOAC.

Trade Smartly!

At NOAC, there were a couple of Spoof Patch sets that went around. Spoof sets are sets that aren't made by an official lodge, and commonly are to mimic a patch. These are a pain to run into, so be careful and always scan to make sure the patches you're getting is registered with a contingent. Also, be smart and negotiate while trading, don't allow yourself to fall for a 3:1 Trade and feel scammed.

Complete a Set!

Patches are often released in sets of 4, 5 or even 6. When you're trading, try completing sets. It makes the patches worth much more when you have an entire set of them, and will often trade for more, and be seen as much more valuable than having 5 patches from different sets. Putting together a set will pay off, because you will likely find someone who wants the entire set.



Have Fun!

Patch Trading was my favorite part of being at NOAC. If you feel slightly stressed, someone's probably trying to pull a fast one on you. Patch Trading is a blast, and you get to collect so much. Not only that, but patches also bring memories. Every single patch that I have from NOAC, I have some story from the person who gave it to me, about why it was made or something that they did.

Unit Elections Wants You!


