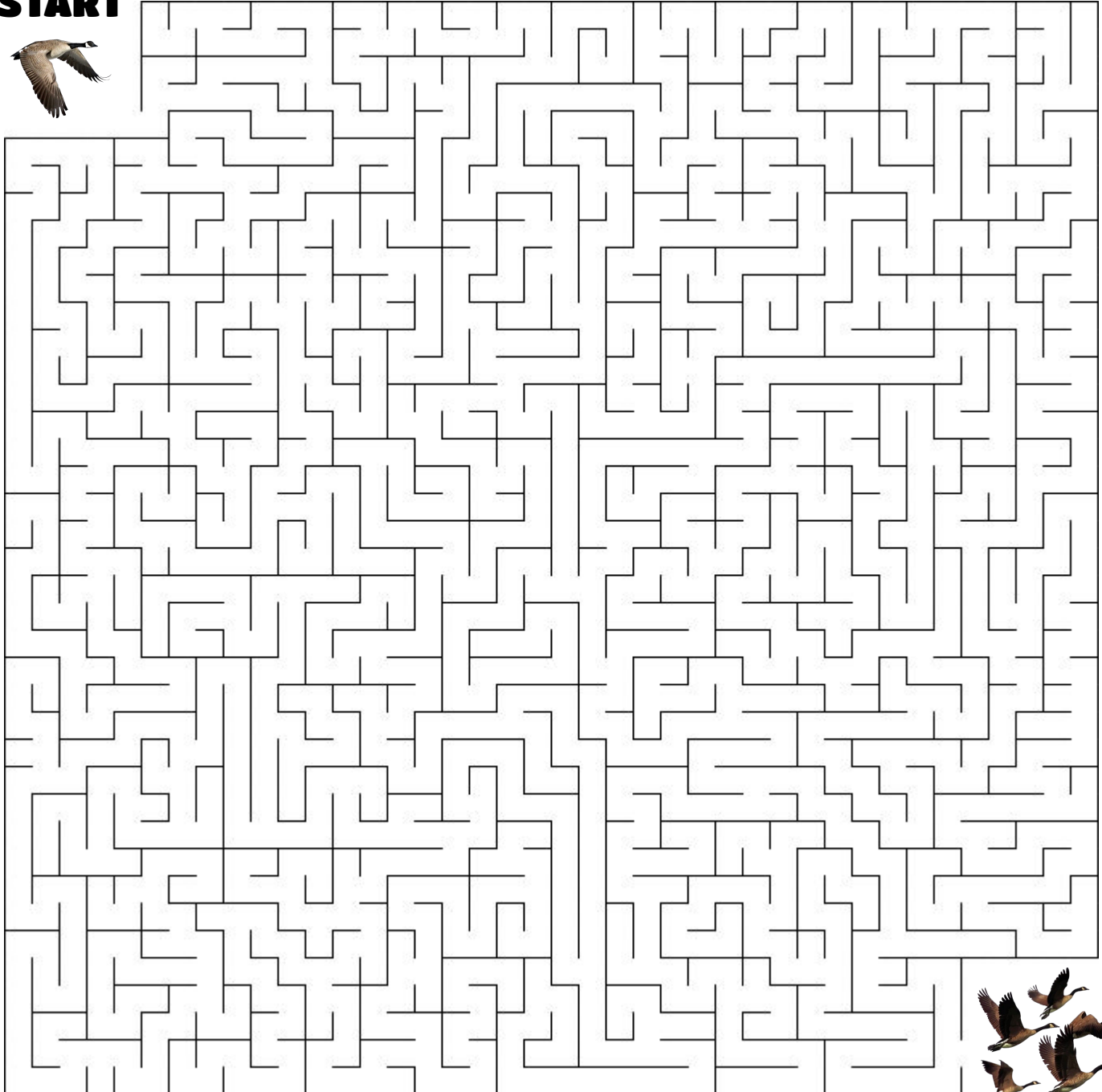
Come to the LLT Meetings!
